### **Challenge Course: Low Elements**

The low element section of our Challenge Course is an essential part in our philosophy of experiential education and learning. It incorporates initiatives that use props, wooden, and wire structures that require the participant to find solutions to physical and mental challenges. ***Please note*** that not all elements will be used during your groups time, elements are selected for their use depending on your group's time on the challenge course and your group's specific goals and their demonstrated progress.

### **Challenge Course: High Elements**

The high elements at our challenge course are all safely belayed structures 20 to 60 feet in the air and allow participants to step outside of their comfort zones and experience risk in a safe atmosphere. ***Please note*** a requirement of three hours of our Low Challenge Course Experience must be completed before this. This is because people are far more comfortable with the risk, when they have worked with people beforehand, it will also allow them to be more successful.

### **Recreational Activities**

Choosing the recreational option is a fun way to introduce the ideas of teamwork and support into your groups activities. These are also facilitated by our highly trained staff. ***Please note*** if you are participating in the "Swamp" activity a change of clothes and shoes are extremely recommended.

### **Environmental Education**

Our EE based curriculum is adapted from the YMCA iCare program.

Classes are designed to teach the essentials of Environmental Awareness.

All classes are approx. 1 - 1 ¼ Hr in length.

### **Outdoor Living Skills**

Learn the basic skills needed to survive in the outdoors.

Classes include:

Basic Orienteering, & Outdoor Survival Skills

All classes are approx. 1 Hr in length.

### **Archery**

Instruction and activity are approx. 1 Hr in length.

### **Arts & Crafts**

Candle Dipping

Tie-Dye (bring your own shirt or buy \$5 per shirt)

Eco-Art

All classes are approx. 1 Hr in length.

### **Recreation Programs (led by our skilled camp staff)**

Activities for all ages! Use for a break in your programming or just for something fun and different. All programs are Approx. 1 Hr in length.

Programs include: **Ultimate Frisbee, wacky relays, 101 Tag Games, Ocky Olympics**

### **Evening Programs**

Hayride, campfires, night-hike, observatory

Special Guest Presenters - for an additional fee, we will be happy to book local presenters that will enhance your program! (e.g. - Wildlife presentation, square dance, DJ and more).

### **Boating/Canoeing**

Offered from mid April - mid October.

### **Swimming**

Memorial weekend to Labor Day weekend.

### **Equestrian Programs**

Based on availability \$27 per person (30-45 min trail ride).

Minimum of 50 people/day.

### **Self-run programs**

#### **Rec. Fields**

Each camp has its own recreation field available for use. They also include soccer nets. Please call and reserve if you would like to use one of these fields for a specific event.

### **Basketball Courts**

Ockanickon has a basketball court and Matolly has courts on the tennis court.

The courts are also great for outdoor dances. Both Courts have lights.

### **Volleyball**

Camp Ockanickon has a lighted sand volleyball court.

### **Softball**

Camp Ockanickon has a diamond and backstop on the field.
