



## 2010 Program Rates

- Minimum group size is 20 people.
- All groups are required to pay their minimum number of participants.
- All prices will include lodging, meals, programs, 1 evening program, & 1 snack.
- Prices are for children and adults.
- All Programs start after the 1st meal & end before the last meal. All programs in addition will require additional staff charges (\$100 per staff member).
- Prices are for all students/teachers/chaperones.
- 1 teacher/chaperone per 30 children free of charge, school groups only.
- 1 YMCA Staff member per 20 participants, all additional staff members will cost an additional \$100 per staff member per day regardless of time spent with group. Additional staff will be required for some programs (boating, high ropes).

### Up-grade charges

Firewood: \$10 per load, up to 3 loads per day.

YMCA Staff supported campfires in which we light for group (wood included); \$20

YMCA Staff supported campfires in which we offer songs & S'mores (wood & S'mores included): \$60

\$100 per additional YMCA staff member.

### Meal up-grades

\$2 per person per additional snack

\$3 per person for ice cream social

\$8 for breakfast, \$8 for lunch, \$10 for dinner

\$2 per person for upgraded meal.

\$3 per person for all BBQ's.

### **Challenge Course: Low Elements**

The low element section of our Challenge Course is an essential part in our philosophy of experiential education and learning. It incorporates initiatives that use props, wooden, and wire structures that require the participant to find solutions to physical and mental challenges. ***Please note*** that not all elements will be used during your groups time, elements are selected for their use depending on your group's time on the challenge course and your group's specific goals and their demonstrated progress.

### **Challenge Course: High Elements**

The high elements at our challenge course are all safely belayed structures 20 to 60 feet in the air and allow participants to step outside of their comfort zones and experience risk in a safe atmosphere. ***Please note*** a requirement of three hours of our Low Challenge Course Experience must be completed before this. This is because people are far more comfortable with the risk, when they have worked with people beforehand, it will also allow them to be more successful.

### **Recreational Activities**

Choosing the recreational option is a fun way to introduce the ideas of teamwork and support into your groups activities. These are also facilitated by our highly trained staff. ***Please note*** if you are participating in the "Swamp" activity a change of clothes and shoes are extremely recommended.

### **Environmental Education**

Choose from our most popular classes listed below.

Classes include:

iCARE classes; Connection Inspection; Pinelands 101; Nature Hikes. All classes are approx. 1 – 1 ¼ Hr in length.

### **Outdoor Living Skills**

Learn the basic skills needed to survive in the outdoors.

Classes include:

Basic Orienteering, Fire Building or Shelter Building. All classes are approx. 1 Hr in length.

### **Archery**

Instruction and activity are approx. 1 Hr in length.

### **Arts & Crafts**

All classes are approx. 1 Hr in length.

### **Recreation Programs (led by our skilled camp staff)**
