## The “Things to Leave at Home” List

- Being in a natural environment designed for children to get a break from the pressures of the world, Camp will continue with, and enforce, the policy of no electronic equipment or equipment that requires the use of electrical outlets. These include, but are not limited to:
  - ✓ CD/Tape/iPod/MP3 Players
  - ✓ Radios or T.V.'s
  - ✓ Electronic Games
  - ✓ Cellular Phones or Pagers
  - ✓ Laptop Computers or P.D.A.'s
  - ✓ Hair dryers, Hair Straighteners, Curling Irons, etc.

If it is discovered that your child does have any of these items after you leave, the items will be locked up in the office until the camper checks out.

- To avoid the possibility of loss, we request that campers do not bring valuables to camp, including irreplaceable sentimental items, expensive clothing or jewelry.
- Immediate expulsion without refund may occur if a camper is found in the possession of and/or using:
  - ✓ Illegal drugs and/or paraphernalia
  - ✓ Any tobacco products
  - ✓ Alcohol
  - ✓ Knives, guns, or any kind of weapon
  - ✓ Fireworks or explosives
  - ✓ Matches, lighters, or candles
- Energy Drinks are not allowed at Camp.

We urge parents to pack their child's belongings for or with them in an effort to ensure that you are aware of what your camper is bringing to camp.
